English

This term we will be using the text 'The Owl and the Pussy Cat' as a focus for our work in English. We will be focussing on using the correct punctuation, different sentence openers and adjectives, nouns and verbs.

Science

In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be discussing which animals would be best suited to a particular habitat. We will also explore simple food chains within different habitats.

Maths

This term we will focus on reading and writing numbers to 100, recognising place value of each digit in two digit numbers, comparing and ordering numbers to 100 and recalling and using addition and subtraction facts to 10. We will also be adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers.

RE

In our RE lessons this half term we will be focussing on the religion Islam. Children will be learning about the important beliefs in Islam.

PE

In PE, we will be focussing on Athletics and Racket skills. We will be practising our running, jumping and throwing skills. We will be focussing on using control and accuracy.

History

Our History topic this half term focuses on the big question 'how have we learnt more about our world?'

We will be learning about the explorers Neil Armstrong, Christopher Columbus, Captain Scott and David Livingstone.

Geography

Our Geography topic this half term focuses on skills and fieldwork in our surrounding environment. We will be looking at maps, using geographical vocabulary and describing the human and physical features.

Music

In our Music lessons this half term we will be finding out all about South African music. We will be listening to and appraising a range of songs and then combining our own sounds to make our own style of music.

ART

In Art we will be focussing on colour mixing, shading, tinting and creating art work based on animals. We will be looking at a range of artists work and comparing based on the skills we have learnt

Computing

In computing this half term, we will be learning how to stay safe online. We will also be focussing on how to search effectively.
