Sounds of the week Review

We will be having daily phonic sessions using our new phonics scheme and reviewing all the sounds learnt so far this half term.

<u>Topic focus — Autumn</u> <u>animals</u>

We will be focussing on hedgehogs this week. We will be using non-fiction books to learn new facts and will be making our own hedgehog models and art work.

Maths work— 4 sided shapes

We will be investigating shapes with 4 sides and will be talking about the properties of squares and rectangles.
