English

This term we will be using the text 'Man on the Moon' as a focus for our work in English. We will be focussing on using the correct punctuation, different sentence openers and adjectives, nouns and verbs.

Science

In Science we will be continuing to focus on living things and their habitats. We will be discussing which animals would be best suited to a particular habitat. We will also explore simple food chains within different habitats.

PE

On Wednesdays, we will be focussing on different passes. Children will be working in partners to show chest passes, bounce basses and underarm and over arm throws. On Mondays, we will be starting our new apparatus unit. Children will have the chance to practise using the apparatus accurately and with control.

Music

In our Music lessons this half term we will be focussing on learning and performing songs linking to the theme of Christmas. Children will be able to learn how to play the glockenspiel and compose their own song.

Maths

This term we will focus on fractions, continuing to focus on multiplication and division and we will also be looking at addition and subtraction with two 2-digit numbers. We will also be recapping our work on 2-D and 3-D shape and then moving onto money and time.


RE

During this half term the children will continue to learn all about the religion Islam and will be applying their knowledge from last half term.

<u>History</u>

Our History topic this half term focuses on the big question 'how have we learnt more about our world?'

We will be learning about the explorers Neil Armstrong, Christopher Columbus, Captain Scott and David Livingstone.



DT

In DT we will be focussing on creating our own moving vehicles. Children will use their knowledge from last half term in terms of joining and constructing. Children will cerate their own moving vehicle.

Computing

During this half term the children will continue learn how to use ICT to type / edit text and create images. They will investigate how to change the size, colour and font and add images to decorate their work.
