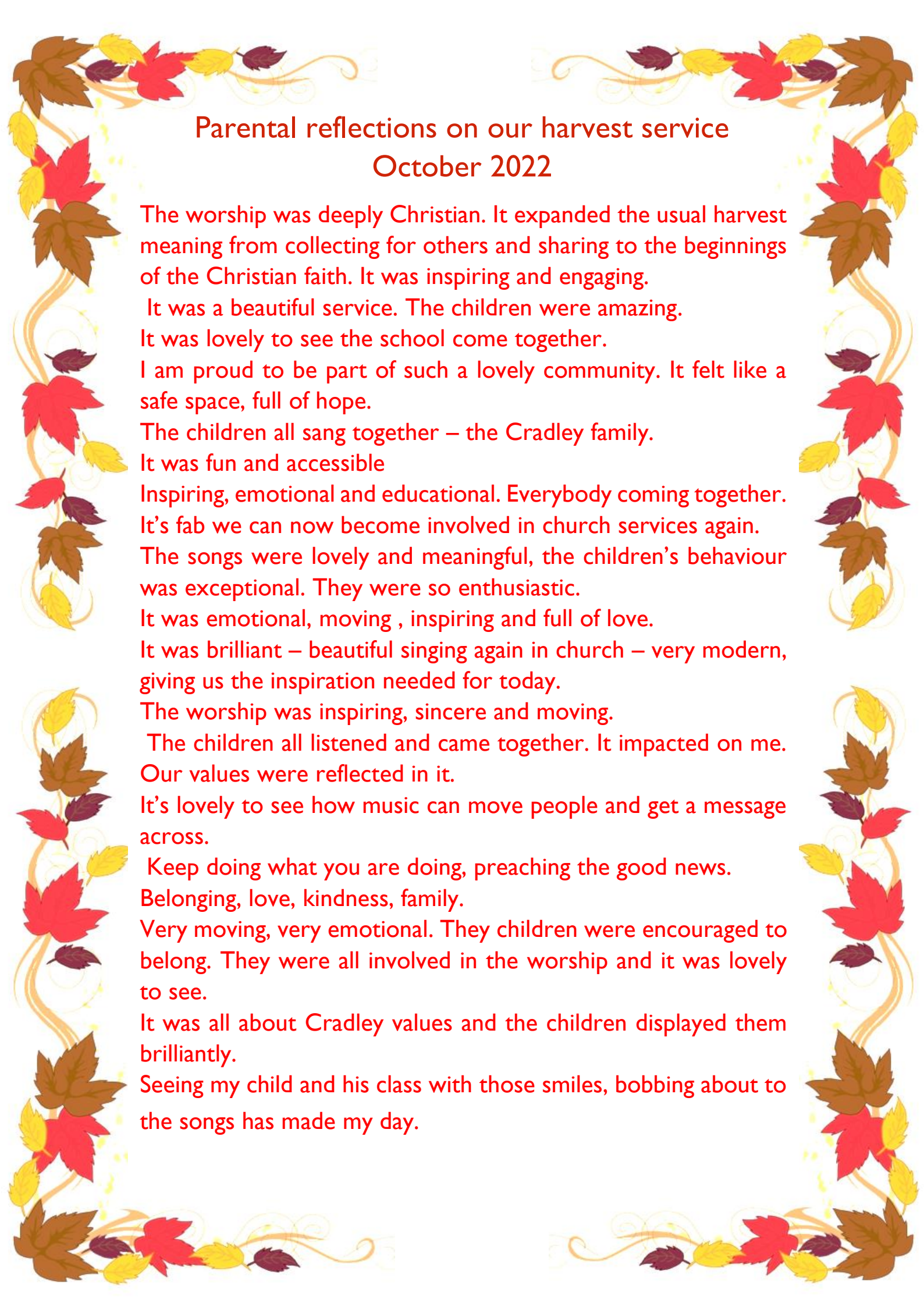




Parental reflections on our harvest service October 2022
